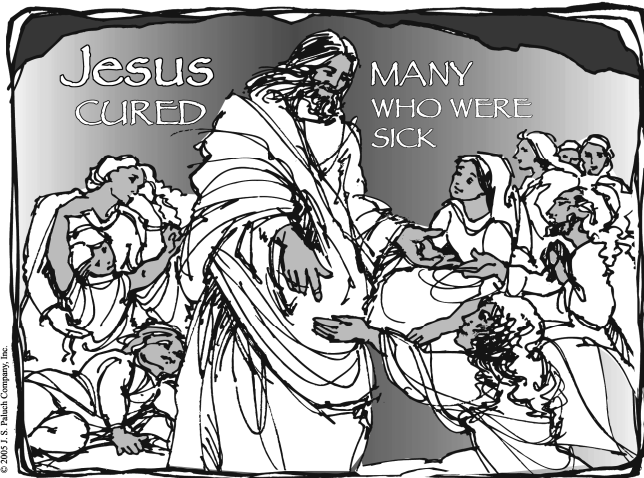

Catholic Stewardship Appeal:

As of 1-31-21 we have met \$5,130.00 of our \$5,550.00 goal. The CSA goal for the diocese is \$2,450,000. (received \$2,288,229.). After the diocese meets its goal, any parish meeting their individual goal is eligible to receive a rebate of 10% of the goal, plus 90% of any funds raised above the goal. Parish goals must be met with cash and/or pledges received by March 15, 2021 and fulfilled by the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.
