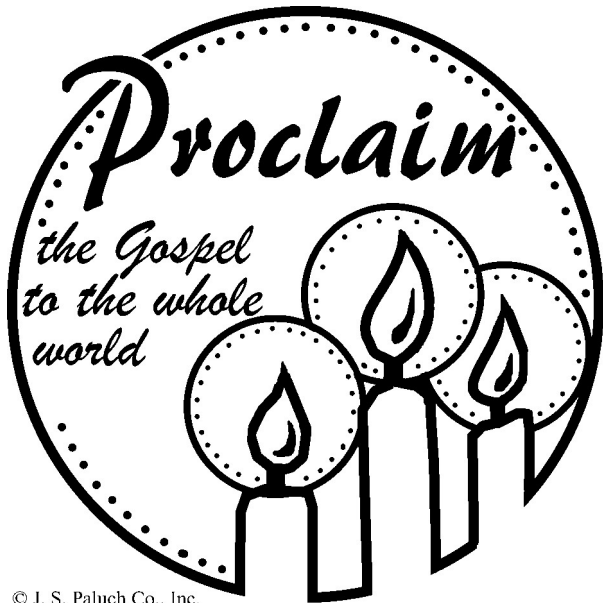

The Chosen is coming to St. Joseph. The Chosen is a television drama based on the life of Jesus Christ. This powerful, educational and deeply touching mini-series is the first-ever multi-season series based on the true stories of the gospels of Jesus Christ. Camp Maccabee was founded in 2009 with the purpose of forming bold, Catholic, masculine leaders. Since then, the camp has evolved into a much-anticipated summer event for many young Catholics across the Diocese of Jefferson City. Campers experience daily adventures, ranging from ropes courses to rafting trips, enrichment with the sacraments, and thought-provoking reflections. Year after year, young men have left the camp with great friendships, and a renewed sense of what it means to be an authentically Catholic man.

Camp Maccabee was named for the Maccabeus clan, the Old Testament family who led a revolt against the Greek Seleucid Empire seeking to destroy the Jewish faith and culture. Like the Maccabeus family, Camp Macabee seeks to build strong men who will courageously fight for what is right, and stand as virtuous Catholic men

The camp is open to young men in high school, including those going into high school in 2021. Camp dates are June 20 to 25 and July 18 to 23.
