FORMED EXPLORE Formed.org is an online program run by the Augustine Institute that has many educational, spiritual, and formational tools to help each of us come to understand more about our faith and come to a deeper relationship with God and His people. The parish pays a yearly fee for this access. This fee will be a small price to pay if the program is used well. There are books, audio, movies, and such — appropriate for all ages.

There are changes to the sign in for FORMED. Go to the register section of Formed.org. Search for a parish (St. Mary Glasgow, MO) enter your name and your email address. A verification email will be sent by Formed to your email address. Verify it and you are good to go. It is that easy!
