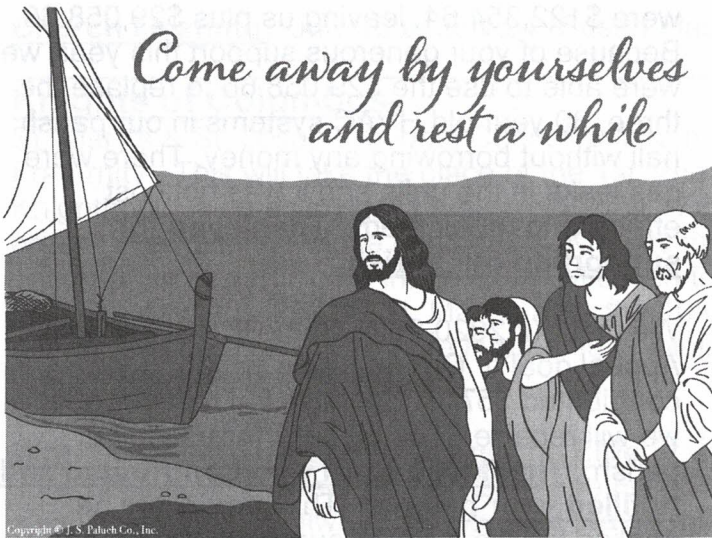

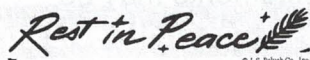

Fiscal year 7/1/2020—6/30/2021 our total income was \$151,413.30 and our expenses were \$122,354.64, leaving us plus \$29,058.66. Because of your generous support this year, we were able to use the \$29,058.66 to replace the three, 30 year old HVAC systems in our parish hall without borrowing any money. There were gas leaks in the units and it was not cost effective to repair them. **Thank you for supporting our parish.**

We met our 2020-2021 Catholic Stewardship Appeal goal !! Our goal was \$5500. & we contributed \$5705. Because we met our goal, we will receive \$734.50 back for use in our parish. **Thank you to all who contributed and fulfilled your pledges.** This money will be applied to chip away at our \$4400.00 property insurance bill that comes out of our general offertory fund and is due August 31.

In your offertory envelopes there is an (optional) envelope for the Catholic Missourian. Every household receives the Catholic Missourian and it is suggested that each family help offset the cost (\$14.00 per family, per year) which is paid out of our general offertory fund. **Thank you for supporting our Catholic newspaper.**

This weekend is our annual Diocesan Mission Collection. We currently have 15 priests serving in our Diocese from countries in Africa and India. Each year we take up a collection to support the mission office. The funds, in part, are used to help the dioceses that make the sacrifice of sharing their priests with our diocese. Other funds are used to support special projects in Latin America and the Philippines. **Thank you for your support.**
