Jefferson City Project Homeless Connect is a one day event meant to help those persons who are homeless or near-homeless overcome as many barriers to permanent housing as possible. Through the help of local social service agencies, local churches, local businesses, and many volunteers this event is possible. The event will be held on Friday, October 8th 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. Some of the services offered are: basic medical, dental extractions, vision screening and eyeglasses, non-drivers identification cards, housing counseling and placement, employment services, substance use and mental health counseling, veterans benefits and services, bus passes, hair cuts and showers, laundry services and a hot lunch.
