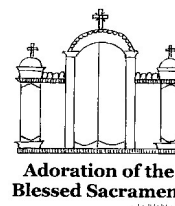

October Count—The Diocese has involved itself in a common pastoral practice across the United States known as the ‘October Count.’ The month of October provides a time when attendance is a good indicator of average attendance. This is a practical tool for pastoral planning. Ushers will take count of attendance the first four Sundays in October.

We must have at least one person in the church at all times with the Blessed Sacrament. There are sign up sheets at each entrance of church..
