**We will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesday, April 26th from 2:00 pm to 5:45 pm.** Benediction and Mass will follow. We must have at least one person in the church at all times with the Blessed Sacrament. There are sign up sheets at each entrance of church. Times are broken down in hour increments, but please know that you may come and spend any time with the Blessed Sacrament.



**Divine Mercy Sunday:** Through a gracious donation, we have received a beautiful new outdoor Image of the Divine Mercy. Sunday, April 24th, immediately following Mass, we will process (as part of the recessional) to the image for its blessing and praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet. It will be outdoors (front of church), weather permitting.

The Image of Jesus, The Divine Mercy, is to be venerated on Divine Mercy Sunday. It is to be given a place of honor in our churches and homes on this Sunday. Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina and then directed her to have this appearance of Himself as the Merciful Savior painted and then venerated publicly. He told her, **I want the Image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it** (*Diary of St. Faustina*, 341)."

**Pray the Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet.** (pamphlet on tables)
