EMAIL SCAMS – “SPOOFING”

Email spoofing is becoming all too common these days. *“Email spoofing is a technique used in spam and phishing attacks to trick users into thinking a message came from a person or entity they either know or can trust. In spoofing attacks, the sender forges email headers so that client software displays the fraudulent sender address, which most users take at face value.”* Recently, someone has attempted to “spoof” Fr. Duncan’s diocesan email – so it looks like it came from his email, but when you reply, it sends it to a random, other email. If you receive a suspicious email, it is very important that you DO NOT reply to it. *(Fr. Duncan will never ask for “emergency help” through an email at 11pm at night)* – Feel free to contact the Parish Office if you have any questions or if you think you’ve received a suspicious email.
