The Diocese of Jefferson City has set forth **Safe Environment policies** for all employees, volunteers, religious brothers and sisters, priests, and deacons. The Safe Environment policy has been developed to ensure the safety of our minors, as required by the USCCB's Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. All volunteers in the church (musicians, servers, sacristans, lectors, eucharistic ministers, volunteers at church events, etc.) and employees in the church, whether they have contact with minor children or not, must take a **VIRTUS Protecting God's Children workshop** in person or online. ## Stewardship

Each family will receive a Time and Talent form and a Tithing Commitment form. Forms are expected to be out the weekend of **October 15-16**.

Discipleship calls us to more than membership; it calls us to active stewardship. To support all the ministries of the parish, we need every family's active stewardship in the parish. What does stewardship ask of all members of the parish?

- \* Commitment to ***pray***. That is, actively and regularly attend Mass on weekends and Holy days of Obligation.
- \* Commitment to ***participate***. That is, offer their talents and a portion of their time to serve the parish community and be a part of its fellowship and opportunities for ongoing Christian formation.
- \* Commitment to ***sacrificially give***. That is, generously and proportionately pledge a portion of the "first fruits" of material treasure to support the operation and ministry of the parish church. The goal for Christians is the Biblical tithe (10%) and all are called to strive toward that goal.

All parish families are expected to enshrine these 3 sacrificial commitments through the completion of annual *Catholic Stewardship Renewal* form. In addition, parish families must strive to stay current on their commitment in order to be considered active stewards in the parish.

Mike helps us to understand stewardship and helps us to understand why the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on Sunday is so important, and a vital part to our stewardship commitment.
