Buddy Packs is a program sponsored through the Ministerial Alliance and the Food Pantry. This program sends non perishable/easy open foods home with kids over the weekend. To keep consistency in the program specific guidelines are given for food donations. If you would like to make a monetary donation—make your check payable to Ministerial Alliance, marked Buddy Pack Program. There are cards on the tables at the entrances that have specific food items for the buddy packs. You may leave food on the counter at the back door of church.

CSA to CSR... By now you should have received a letter from the Diocese explaining that there will be no (annual) Catholic Stewardship Appeal this coming Fall as we have had in the past. Instead, the diocese is asking that you prayerfully include what you would have sent in to the CSA into your ongoing tithe to your parish. Ultimately, as a Stewardship Parish, we have absorbed our CSA goal (Last year our goal was \$13,260) into what is now our *tithe* to the diocese – meaning that our monthly payment has gone up from years past when we just had a Cathedraticum payment alone. Previously, too, when you would give to the CSA & if we met our goal, then 10% would come back to the Parish. Now, if you give what you previously gave to the CSA, 90% will stay in the Parish. More information will be coming out to explain this, but our monthly tithe payments are crucial for not only our support of the larger Church, but we also benefit tremendously from all of the services that the diocese provides that we would otherwise have to hire out ourselves (at an exponentially higher cost to us) – things like group insurance rates and HR/payroll staff, access to specialized lawyers, property management, etc. etc. While it seems like our payment might be increasing, we still have to look at the larger picture of how much we actually save – and are still supporting the universal mission of the larger Church at the same time – as a Diocese, we are *Better Together!*
