The funds from the collection are used, in part, to help fund projects in dioceses from which our mission priests come, as well as other Catholic mission projects. We support various special projects, such as schools, water wells, solar powered generators, youth centers and the building and renovating of churches. These are just a few examples of the many projects we have supported in mission lands over the past few years.
