If it is not an emergency but you'd like Father to visit in the hospital, please talk to him to arrange a time for a visit.

Sacraments of Baptism or Marriage: a preparation process is required before either of these Sacraments is celebrated. Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.

Fayette Food Pantry - August is the month that St. Joseph helps at the Fayette Food Pantry. **Tuesday, August 22nd** we will help pack food at 7:00 pm. **Thursday, August 24th** we will help with distribution from 1:00 to 3:00 pm. Entrance to the Food Pantry is at the back of the Keller building on Williams St. The food pantry accepts donations of non-perishable food items (canned fruit and vegetables, soup, peanut butter, cereal, pastas, rice, beans). The pantry is also in need of personal hygiene items (deodorant, shampoo, soap, toothbrush/toothpaste). They do appreciate the donations of the plastic grocery sacks. Donated items and sacks may be left on the counter at the back door of church.


