This year, all parishes in our diocese are participating in the annual Catholic Stewardship Renewal on the weekend of October 21-22. It will be very similar to what we did last October in 2022. This process is a deeply spiritual one which allows us to re-affirm our support of the mission and ministries of our parish by committing to pray (that is, attend weekend and holy day Mass), participate (that is share our talent to build up the parish community), and sacrificially give (that is, pledge a gift of treasure to financially support the work of the parish). ***All parishioners are asked to participate in this process***, the goal of which is to strengthen the ministry of the parish by calling everyone into a deeper level of discipleship and relationship with the Lord Jesus.
