Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.

ST. MARY DAILY MASS TIME CHANGE –

Beginning Wednesday June 5, 2024, the Daily Mass (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday) for St. Mary, Glasgow, will be **8:00 AM** instead of 8:15am. We will not be changing it back once school begins because it was decided that the school day will begin at 7:50am instead of 7:55am.
