Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.

- A rural and beautiful environment and the opportunity to walk the grounds.

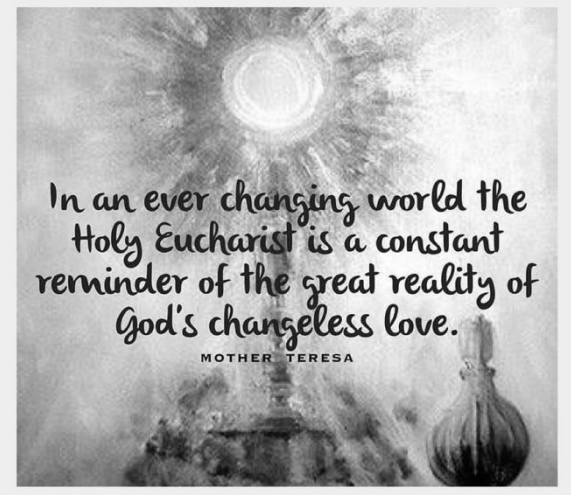
