**New Format for Offertory Tithing – FY 24-25*

Last Fiscal Year, 2023-2024, our parish took in \$148,844.95 of Offertory Tithing. While our QuickBooks categories are in the process of being upgraded to be more transparent in the future, our actual operating expenses is around \$153,000.00. This is a **net operating loss** of nearly \$4,200. As you may be aware, expenses across the board are increasing. For example, we just paid our yearly Property Insurance which was around \$5,800. Insurance has skyrocketed over the past couple of years, but the Diocese is helping us tremendously in not passing along the direct cost right away to us; rather over several years to adjust. Utilities are increasing as well, and we need to pay our employees a just wage to keep up with the inflation/cost of living increases we are experiencing. Therefore, to keep up with expenses, after studying the numbers, **we truly need around \$3,100.00 per week to operate.** Last year, we took in an average of \$2,862 per week. This is around \$238 more per week needed. A more detailed finance report is to follow this Fall, especially regarding some of our restricted* funds on deposit with the Diocese. (*restricted = we have these funds set aside for a specific parish purpose, meaning they are for specific intended uses, i.e. Campus HVAC, Parish Hall, etc.)

The process adults take to be initiated into the Catholic faith, known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is now called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA).

This change reflects a closer translation of the process by which adults are initiated into the Catholic faith.

This change may not seem like much, but the new name highlights that the process to become Catholic could occur at any point in the year, not just the typical Easter Vigil. For some it could even take multiple years before making the final decision. As *Philip Kosloski puts it*, the process of joining the Catholic Church “involves a period of intense discernment, and prayer, not simply going through the “rites” at fixed points of the year.” If you would like to learn more about the name change you can visit aleteia.org, where this information came from. WOMEN’S CLINIC SURVEY – COLUMBIA, MISSOURI

Since my time at Newman and before, I have become more and more aware of the need to change the standard of care provided to women. Through talks on the "Genius of the Body" that we have offered regularly here at Newman, I've become concerned with the number of females who express not understanding well the functioning of the female body. And this goes together with the substandard healthcare they have experienced with a majority of healthcare providers, for example, offering women the quick fix of a pill, a pharmaceutical, contraceptives, in vitro fertilization, etc., which do not respond to the actual problems or issues women are facing. Our Church is pro-woman, and we need to significantly support women's health holistically and ethically with healthcare that listens in order to provide for what their needs are and how God designed their bodies. I'm working with a number of women in Columbia to establish a Women's Health Clinic that will respond to these needs. This is inspired by the Guiding Star Project (founded by Leah Jacobson, author of "Wholistic Feminism"): guidingstarproject.com Such a Clinic will offer essential services such as fertility care, pregnancy care, lactation consultation, pre and post-menopausal care, family support, and several other female health services. Imagine a place where females can go during business hours to learn Natural Family Planning (NFP), feel safe, and know the care they receive aligns with their personal health needs on a regular basis. This could be a culture changing service for Columbia and the surrounding area! At this point, we need to gather some survey data regarding the interest from women. Bishop McKnight is supportive of gathering information with a view toward supporting this project. We have a very brief (7 question) electronic survey that we ask you to share with your parishioners via email, bulletin, social media, etc. **It will be available FOR THREE WEEKS over three weekends: July 13 - July 31.**
