The process adults take to be initiated into the Catholic faith, known as the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is now called the **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)**.

This change reflects a closer translation of the process by which adults are initiated into the Catholic faith. This change may not seem like much, but the new name highlights that the process to become Catholic could occur at any point in the year, not just the typical Easter Vigil. For some it could even take multiple years before making the final decision. As *Philip Kosloski puts it*, the process of joining the Catholic Church “involves a period of intense discernment, and prayer, not simply going through the “rites” at fixed points of the year.” If you would like to learn more about the name change you can visit [aleteia.org](http://aleteia.org), where this information came from.
