STEWARDSHIP PRAYER

Heavenly Father, as we observe Respect Life Month, we are especially mindful of the gift of your Son, Jesus Christ, whose life, ministry, death and resurrection serve to witness Your immeasurable love for us all. May Christ lead us to be good stewards of our brothers and sisters, and to realize that all lives we bring to Him are sacred and deserve to be looked upon in Your image and likeness. Strengthen those who devote their lives to nurturing the most vulnerable, including the sick, the aged, children and those yet to be born. Let their witness give us the courage and resolve to proclaim the Gospel of Life to all whom we encounter. And send your Holy Spirit upon us to give us the wisdom and resolve to be servants of humankind, living icons of Christ, the servant of us all. We ask all this in Jesus' name. Amen.

October is the month we renew our Stewardship with Sunday, October 20th being Stewardship Commitment Sunday. Prayerfully consider what you can offer back to your parish in the four pillars of Stewardship – Hospitality, Prayer, Formation, and Service. The Catholic Stewardship Renewal is not just something which is administrative but is also deeply *spiritual*. It is the yearly opportunity for each parishioner to purposefully and prayerfully review, redirect, reaffirm and recommit.

- **Reviewing & Redirecting** allows parishioners to ask themselves the following questions: How am I doing at striving to live as an active steward in my parish? How is my Mass attendance? How do I participate in the communal life of the parish? How well does my level of giving support the ministries of the parish?
- **Reaffirming & Recommitting** allows parishioners – on a yearly basis – to concretely proclaim “Yes! I am a part of this parish, and I am supportive of its mission and ministries!”

ADULT FAITH FORMATION – “*When we Pray*” Cultivate a rich and lasting prayer life. You know prayer is important but still find it challenging. Perhaps it’s hard to find time, or you’re unsure what to do when you pray. Or maybe you feel discouraged by your weaknesses and your inability to overcome them, you are not alone. Many of the saints struggled in prayer. They were like us. But each time they fell, they got up again and learned to rely more on God’s grace. What God did in the lives of countless saints, he wants to do in the lives of ordinary people like us. And that’s what this study is about: the journey of prayer God wants to take us on.
