Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick: If you know of anyone needing the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick or Last Rites, please let Father know. If it is an emergency, please call the office phone or send Father an email. If a family member is in a neighboring hospital (Columbia, etc.) and it is an emergency, please let your doctor or nurse know to contact a Priest – they have priests on-call every day of the week at the larger hospitals. If it is not an emergency but you'd like Father to visit in the hospital, please talk to him to arrange a time for a visit.

Sacraments of Baptism or Marriage: a preparation process is required before either of these Sacraments is celebrated. Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.

PSR UPDATE – Practice for first communion will be right after Mass today.

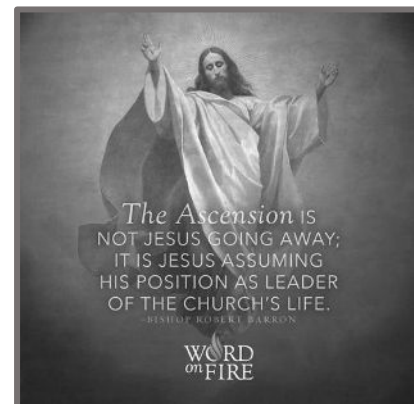
FELLOWSHIP – Join us after Mass in the parish hall next Sunday for fellowship. We will also be honoring our first communion kids and recent high school graduates!

+ **UNIFORM INFORMATION** – Due to Dennis Uniform no longer being in business, we are in a transition phase with uniforms. The plaid St. Mary currently uses is not available. Girls may continue to wear their plaid jumpers or navy skirt. Girls may also wear the following options from French Toast. -Kindergarten through Fifth Grade-Box Pleat Jumper (navy) -Sixth through Eighth Grades-Pleated Two-Tab Skirt (navy). White or red shirts may be worn with their uniforms. The boys’ uniforms have not changed. They are to wear navy pants or shorts.
