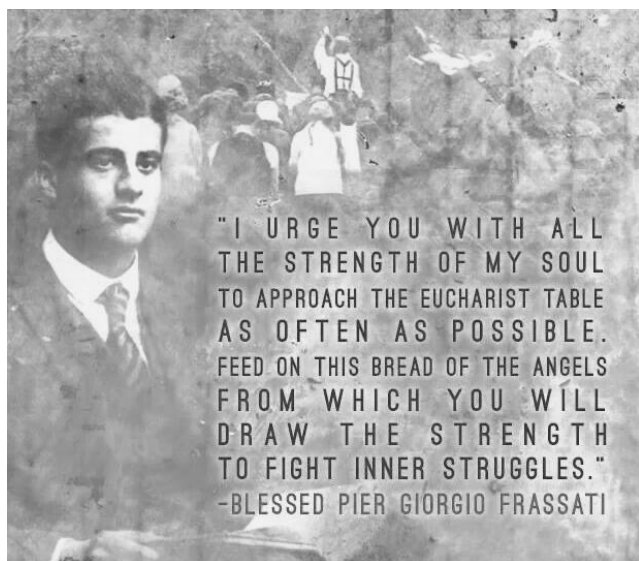

**LAST CHANCE TO ENROLL IN CAMP P23** – Camp P23’s July session is right around the corner – July 9<sup>th</sup> through the 11<sup>th</sup> in Camdenton, MO. Camp P23 is an overnight summer camp for junior high boys that pulls from Psalm 23 in looking at Christ and his priests through the identity of a shepherd. Over 3 days/2 nights at this outdoor-focused experience, campers join small groups led by seminarians and participate in games, prayer, and activities that promote openness to the priestly vocation.

**CONFIRMATION THIS FALL** – Due to our unique circumstances, Confirmation for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 will occur differently than it has in recent years. Monsignor Kurwicki has determined that while the See is vacant, responsibility for scheduling and celebrating Confirmation will fall to parish pastors and administrators. This includes the few Confirmations which have already been scheduled for this Fall. ***OUR Conferral of the Sacrament of Confirmation (for our current class) is still on for October 1, 2025, at 6:30pm.*** Our Next Confirmation Class will begin forming in the Spring of 2026 for the celebration of the Sacrament in Fall of 2027.

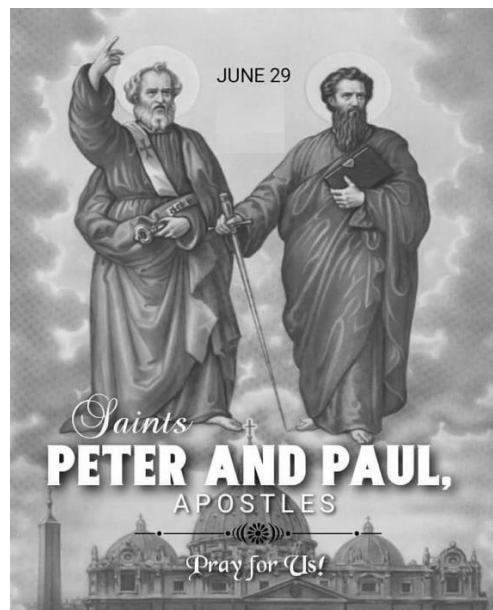
...”faith sharing is enlightening, good for all, very comforting.”
