**Sacraments of Baptism or Marriage:** a preparation process is required before either of these Sacraments is celebrated. Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.



## Good Emperor Henry

Saint Heinrich II

He's more popularly known as Saint Henry II. He was a Holy Roman Emperor and a Benedictine oblate. He was married to Saint Kinigundis. They chose to practice marital celibacy. He impelled Pope Benedict VIII to insert the "Filioque" to the creed which proclaims that "the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son." He also enforced celibacy among the clergy and made bishops government leaders of communities.
