Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick: If you know of anyone needing the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick or Last Rites, please let Father know. If it is an emergency, please call the office phone or send Father an email. If a family member is in a neighboring hospital (Columbia, etc.) and it is an emergency, please let your doctor or nurse know to contact a Priest – they have priests on-call every day of the week at the larger hospitals. If it is not an emergency but you'd like Father to visit in the hospital, please talk to him to arrange a time for a visit.

Sacraments of Baptism or Marriage: a preparation process is required before either of these Sacraments is celebrated. Please contact Father or Parish Secretary at least 6 months before a wedding is planned or as soon as the pregnancy is known so that proper arrangements may be made for the spiritual preparations.



The Apostle to the Apostles

Saint Maryam of Magdala

St. Mary Magdalene was one of the disciples of Jesus who gave donations for the needs of Jesus and the apostles. She was a witness to the crucifixion and death of Jesus. But perhaps her most important role was her being the first person to see the Risen Lord, the first person to be sent by Christ after his resurrection, and the first person to proclaim that Jesus is indeed alive. This earned her the title “the Apostle to the Apostles.”
